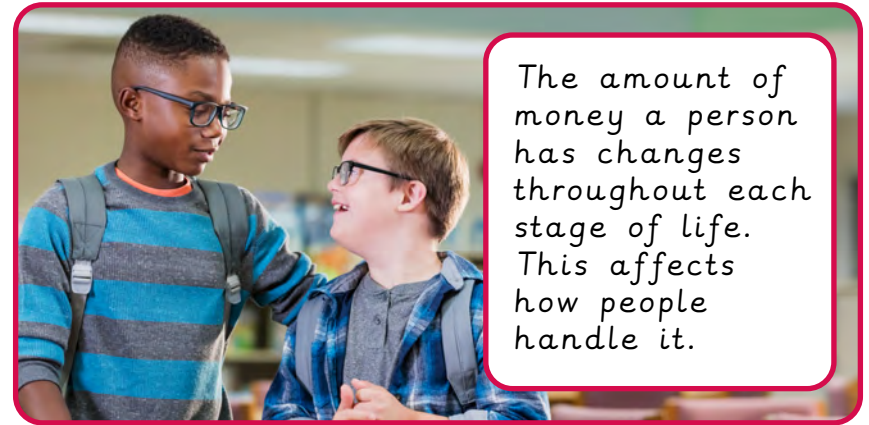


earnings	The money that people receive for the work they do.
