Key words	
Spelling	Definition
Invasion	The aim of the game is to attack the other teams' territory to score a goal/point.
Pass	Successfully send and receive a ball to a teammate.
Pitch	Playing area for the game.
Possession	When your team has the ball.
Receive	Take possession of the ball from a teammate.
Space	An area of the pitch/court where you are not next to your teammates or opponents.
Defend	Protect your goal area—stop the other team from scoring
Attack	To try and score a goal/point in the opponents area.
